- 1. This Invitation for Bids follows the General Procurement Notice (GPN) for this Project that appeared in UN Development Business issue of September 8, 2014.
- 2. Ukraine has received a loan from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD) in US dollars towards the cost of Ukraine District Heating Energy Efficiency Project and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward eligible payments under Contract No.UDHEEP-KHTM-ICB-19B for Installation of SCADA System in the City of Kharkiv. Dispatching of Boiler Houses, Central Heating Stations and DH Pumping Stations.
- 3. Public Utility "Kharkivski teplovi merezhi" now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the design, manufacture, supply, installation, testing, delivery, precommissioning and commissioning of 12 Boiler Houses and CHP, 10 Pumping stations, 204 Central and Individual Heating Substations of the District Heating System in the city of Kharkiv ("the Facilities").

Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding procedures as specified in the World Bank's Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits& Grants by World Bank Borrowers, dated January 2011 as revised through July 2014 Corrigenda ("Procurement Guidelines"), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Guidelines. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 1.6 and 1.7 setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.

4. Qualification requirements for Bidders, including members of joint ventures, subcontractors and manufacturers:

Average Annual Turnover:

Minimum average annual construction turnover of USD 11.0 million calculated as total certified payments received for contracts in progress and/or completed within the last four (4) financial years starting 1st of January, 2015.

General Experience:

Experience under design, supply and installation contracts in the role of prime contractor, JV member, sub-contractor, or management contractor for at least the last six (6) years, starting 1st January, 2014.

Specific Experience:

A minimum number of similar contracts specified below that have been satisfactorily and substantially completed as a prime contractor, joint venture member, management contractor or sub-contractor between 1st January 2014 and application submission deadline: 1 (one) contract of minimum value USD 8 000 000,00 (eight million US dollars) or 2 (two) contracts of minimum value of USD 4 000 000,00 (four million US dollars) each.

For the above or other contracts executed during the period stipulated in 2.4.2(a) above, a minimum experience in the following key activities: Implementation of the SCADA systems lower-level at least at five (5) DHS facilities.

Financial resources:

The Bidder must demonstrate access to, or availability of, financial resources such as liquid assets, unencumbered real assets, lines of credit, and other financial means, other than any contractual advance payments to meet:

- (i) the following cash-flow requirement 1 800 000 USD (one million eight hundred thousand US dollars) over six (6) months; and
- (ii) the overall cash flow requirements for this contract and its current commitments.

Litigation History:

A Bidder shall provide complete information on all the current and past litigations or arbitrations due to the contracts performed or contracts in progress for the last four (4) years.

Personnel:

The Bidder must demonstrate that it will have the personnel for the key positions that comply with qualification requirements established in Ukraine for respective profession and meet the following experience criteria:

- 7. The provisions in the Instructions to Bidders and in the General Conditions of Contract are the provisions of the Bank Standard Bidding Documents for Procurement of Plant Design, Supply, and Installation, revised April 2015.

All bids must be accompanied by a bid security in the form of bank guarantee of at least USD 200 000,00 (two hundred thousand US dollars) or its equivalent in a freely convertible currency. Electronic bids are not permitted. Late bids will be rejected.
